He is the past winner of the American Association of Bovine Practitioners Preventive Medicine Dairy award.

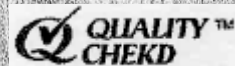

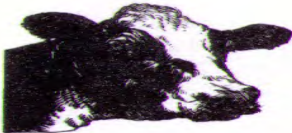
